**Today's Program**

Carlos Perez: Inflation in Venezuela and Argentina

**Last week:** UT Martin meteorology student Noah Melton described his recent 10-day storm chasing trip through nine states at Kiwanis. A West Tennessee native from Sharon, Noah said that this "fantastic UT Martin trip" (May 13-23) included six students and two professors. He explained that May is the peak season for tornados. His presentation included his own dramatic photographs and videos of growing storms in Louisiana, Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, and Iowa, and he mentioned traveling in Tennessee, Arkansas, Illinois, and Kentucky. Noah highlighted selected graphics to illustrate the intensity of the storms. He said that he is certain the group spotted four tornados and perhaps more and that they got "the first real taste of severe weather" on the third day of the trip. Noah also discussed the safety precautions the group took as they used their own equipment (phones and laptops) to follow radar and share knowledge about storms and storm chasing.
