Last week: Joyce Washington, who has been involved in insurance and risk management for more than 40 years, shared valuable information about planning ahead for potential catastrophes

from wind, tornados, flood, ice storms, and earthquakes. Washington urged members to look carefully at their homeowners policy and to be sure to have an inventory of every room and closet in the home. She said that “the best recovery is a preparedness plan” and to be sure that a detailed plan is in place. Washington reviewed that basic survival items include water, medications, food, a battery-powered radio, flashlight with extra batteries, a first aid kit, a whistle to signal for help, plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter in, moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic liners for personal sanitation, local maps, and pet food and supplies as needed. Additionally, Washington noted Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (VOAD), an association of organizations that mitigate and alleviate the impact of disasters. She also urged everyone to review material at the website www.ready.gov, an official website of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. Joyce also distributed several booklets and brochures from FEMA.
