Using technology in a 21st century library—Logan Brimm, director of information technology at Martin Public Library, described available technology and related services at MPL when he gave a presentation for Kiwanis on Oct. 16. He began by highlighting computers and laptops available in the children's library and then described computers available in the teen area, the open computer area, the computer classroom, and the editing/recording area.
